Session 3: Trumpets and Bowls

Last week we ended with the 7th Seal being opened. The opening of this seal begins the seven trumpet judgments. Let's look at what Revelation 8 has to say about these trumpet judgments.

 **First Trumpet: Hail, Fire, blood –**

Notice the warning that the angel gives: three WOES. This is an exclamation of grief or calamity

When this trumpet sounds it is very near the end of Daniel's 70th week. There is a "grace delay" of the events on the earth. In Heaven, the Lord Jesus proclaims His right to the title deed of the earth.

"After the Rapture of the true Church, or believers in Christ, a church will still exist on the earth, but she will be an apostate church. Revelation 17:1 labels the heretic church of the last days as "the great harlot who sits on many waters." A harlot is an individual who has been unfaithful in her wedding vows. Here John portrayed an apostate church that professed to be loyal to Christ but in fact cleaved to idols and a false religious system. This is spiritual adultery. The Antichrist, who will rule over the confederation, will be content for a time to share his power with her, then he will turn on her and destroy her with a vengeance. By eliminating the false church, the Antichrist will be clearing the way for his own cult and his own worship."- John Hagee, From Daniel to Doomsday

At this point the eternal destiny of living person has been determined.

SEVEN BOWLS OF GOD'S WRATH

Revelation 15:5-16:1 ESV

After this I looked, and the sanctuary of the tent of witness in heaven was opened, 6 and out of the sanctuary came the seven angels with the seven plagues, clothed in pure, bright linen, with golden sashes around their chests. 7 And one of the four living creatures gave to the seven angels seven golden bowls full of the wrath of God who lives forever and ever, 8 and the sanctuary was filled with smoke from the glory of God and from his power, and no one could enter the sanctuary until the seven plagues of the seven angels were finished.

16 Then I heard a loud voice from the temple telling the seven angels, "Go and pour out on the earth the seven bowls of the wrath of God."

At this point, there is no reprieve as these final judgments are unleashed on the earth. They are final, and they are severe.



The First Bowl: _____

Revelation 16:2 ESV

So the first angel went and poured out his bowl on the earth, and harmful and painful sores came upon the people who bore the mark of the beast and worshiped its image.

These sores are inflicted on all those who have the mark of the beast.



The Second Bowl: _____

Revelation 16:3 ESV

The second angel poured out his bowl into the sea, and it became like the blood of a corpse, and every living thing died that was in the sea.

The seas turn to blood and every living thing in the ocean dies.



The Third Bowl: _____

Revelation 16:4-7 ESV

The third angel poured out his bowl into the rivers and the springs of water, and they became blood. 5 And I heard the angel in charge of the waters say, "Just are you, O Holy One, who is and who was, for you brought these judgments. 6 For they have shed the blood of saints and prophets, and you have given them blood to drink. It is what they deserve!" 7 And I heard the altar saying, "Yes, Lord God the Almighty, true and just are your judgments!"

After the seas turn to blood, all fresh water then turns to blood as well. The reason is clear, it is for the shed blood of the saints and the prophets.



The Fourth Bowl: _____

Revelation 16:8-9 ESV

The fourth angel poured out his bowl on the sun, and it was allowed to scorch people with fire. 9 They were scorched by the fierce heat, and they cursed the name of God who had power over these plagues. They did not repent and give him glory.

The sun's rays burn, and scorch people and it also causes an extreme heat wave. And all those sun scorched people curse and blaspheme God



The Fifth Bowl: _____

Revelation 16:10-11 ESV

The fifth angel poured out his bowl on the throne of the beast, and its kingdom was plunged into darkness. People gnawed their tongues in anguish 11 and cursed the God of heaven for their pain and sores. They did not repent of their deeds.

Satan's throne is hurled into darkness and judgment is poured out. There is nothing that can be done since there is not truth or light in him or his followers.



The Sixth Bowl: _____

Revelation 16:12-16 ESV

The sixth angel poured out his bowl on the great river Euphrates, and its water was dried up, to prepare the way for the kings from the east. 13 And I saw, coming out of the mouth of the dragon and out of the mouth of the beast and out of the mouth of the false prophet, three unclean spirits like frogs. 14 For they are demonic spirits, performing signs, who go abroad to the kings of the whole world, to assemble them for battle on the great day of God the Almighty. 15 ("Behold, I am coming like a thief! Blessed is the one who stays awake, keeping his garments on, that he may not go about naked and be seen exposed!") 16 And they assembled them at the place that in Hebrew is called Armageddon.

The Lord causes the great Euphrates to completely dry up and it prepares the way for the great army and the battle of Armageddon. The 200 hundred-million-man oriental army advances and takes advantage of the darkness poured out on the antichrist's capital. This is a suicide war basically. This last battle will be enormous




The Seventh Bowl: _____

Revelation 16:17-21 ESV

The seventh angel poured out his bowl into the air, and a loud voice came out of the temple, from the throne, saying, "It is done!" 18 And there were flashes of lightning, rumblings, peals of thunder, and a great earthquake such as there had never been since man was on the earth, so great was that earthquake. 19 The great city was split into three parts, and the cities of the nations fell, and God remembered Babylon the great, to make her drain the cup of the wine of the fury of his wrath. 20 And every island fled away, and no mountains were to be found. 21 And great hailstones, about one hundred pounds each, fell from heaven on people; and they cursed God for the plague of the hail, because the plague was so severe.

The fierce wrath of God is poured out upon Babylon with thunders, lightnings, and earthquakes. Massive amounts of hail fall and the people continue to curse God. A massive earthquake takes out all cities and nations. Shortly after this final bowl of judgment the awesome return of Jesus Christ, the King of Kings and Lord of Lords, begins.

7 Behold, He is coming with the clouds, and every eye will see Him, even those who pierced Him; and all the tribes of the earth shall gaze upon Him and beat their breasts and mourn and lament over Him. Even so [must it be]. Amen (so be it).

For the Lord is indignant against all nations, and His wrath is against all their host. He has utterly doomed them, He has given them over to slaughter.

Zechariah 14:2-4 AMP

For I will gather all nations against Jerusalem to battle, and the city shall be taken and the houses rifled and the women ravished; and half of the city shall go into exile, but the rest of the people shall not be cut off from the city. 3 Then shall the Lord go forth and fight against those nations, as when He fought in the day of battle. 4 And His feet shall stand in that day upon the Mount of Olives, which lies before Jerusalem on the east, and the Mount of Olives shall be split in two from the east to the west by a very great valley; and half of the mountain shall remove toward the north and half of it toward the south

Revelation 19:7-9, 11-14 AMP

7 Let us rejoice and shout for joy [exulting and triumphant]! Let us celebrate and ascribe to Him glory and honor, for the marriage of the Lamb [at last] has come, and His bride has prepared herself. 8 She has been permitted to dress in fine (radiant) linen, dazzling and white—for the fine linen is (signifies, represents) the righteousness (the upright, just, and godly living, deeds, and conduct, and right standing with God) of the saints (God’s holy people). 9 Then [the angel] said to me, Write this down: Blessed (happy, to be envied) are those who are summoned (invited, called) to the marriage supper of the Lamb. And he said to me [further], These are the true words (the genuine and exact declarations) of God.

11 After that I saw heaven opened, and behold, a white horse [appeared]! The One Who was riding it is called Faithful (Trustworthy, Loyal, Incorruptible, Steady) and True, and He passes judgment and wages war in righteousness (holiness, justice, and uprightness). 12 His eyes [blaze] like a flame of fire, and on His head are many kingly crowns (diadems); and He has a title (name) inscribed which He alone knows or can understand. 13 He is dressed in a robe dyed by dipping in blood, and the title by which He is called is The Word of God. 14 And the troops of heaven, clothed in fine linen, dazzling and clean, followed Him on white horses.

Zechariah 14:9-11 AMP

9 And the Lord shall be King over all the earth; in that day the Lord shall be one [in the recognition and worship of men] and His name one. 10 All the land shall be turned into a plain from Geba to Rimmon, [the Rimmon that is] south of Jerusalem. But Jerusalem shall remain lifted up on its site and dwell in its place, from Benjamin’s gate to the place of the First Gate, to the Corner Gate, and from the Tower of Hananel to the king’s winepresses. 11 And it shall be inhabited, for there shall be no more curse or ban of utter destruction, but Jerusalem shall dwell securely.
