1. THE RAPTURE IS A______

1 Corinthians 15:51 TPT

Listen, and I will tell you a divine mystery: not all of us will die, but we will all be transformed.

"Mystery" – in the original Greek is G3466 mysterion, means something

, but now revealed to the true believer.

First, Paul states that flesh and blood cannot enter into God's presence, but that we must first die, and then be raised in a new, eternal, form.

2. The RAPTURE MEANS______

There were two partial examples of the Rapture in the Word of God. Let's look at those:

- Genesis 5:21-24; Hebrews 11:5
- **2 Kings 2:9-11** Both of these men were taken directly into heaven without experiencing physical death.

1 Corinthians 15:51 AMP

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Take notice! I tell you a mystery (a secret truth, an event decreed by the hidden purpose or counsel of God). We shall not all fall asleep [in death], but we shall all be changed (transformed)

"Change" – G236 *allasso* – to change, to ______ one thing for another, to transform, to make ______. To change: to cause one thing to ______ and another to take its place.

All believers will be transformed in body and nature into new bodies that are suited for the eternal, spiritual, incorruptible realm in which God dwells.

4. The RAPTURE IS______

1 Corinthians 15:52 TPT It will happen in an instant —in the twinkling of his eye.

Here in the Passion, they use the word "*instant*." In the KJV is uses the word "*moment*." Instant is a good definition, but in reality, it goes even deeper than that.

"Moment" – G823 *atomos* – that cannot be cut in two, or divided, ______, of a moment of time.

This word of is made of two words, *Alpha* and *tomos* which means sharper. It is the word used in **Hebrews 4:12** that states the Word is sharper than any two-edged sword.

So, what does all this mean? The Rapture will occur so quickly and suddenly that the time frame in which it happens cannot be humanly divided. In a flash of a second, every living human believer on earth will be gone.

5. The RAPTURE IS A____

1 Thessalonians 4:15-18

Vs 16 And those who have departed this life in Christ will rise first

"Rise up" – G450 *anistemi* (verb) to cause to rise up, raise up, to raise up from lying down, raise up from the dead, raise up, to cause to appear, bring forward. This is a literal meaning...the dead in Christ will rise first.

Vs 17 Then we, the *living* ones who remain [on the earth], shall simultaneously be <u>caught up</u> along with [the resurrected dead] in the clouds to <u>meet</u> the Lord in the air;

"Living" – G2198 *zao* – to live, breath, be among the living, having vital power. This is the root word of Zoe, which is the "God-kind" of life.

The ______ which has been birthed in you.

Paul is not speaking of just "the living." He is specifically referring to those who are born again after the nature and life of God.

"Caught up" – G726 *harpazo* (verb) to seize, carry off by force, claim for one's self eagerly, to snatch out or away.

"Clouds" – G3507 *nephele* means a cloud, used of the cloud that led Israel in the wilderness. It is from the root word G3509 *nephos* which means a cloud, a dense multitude, or throng of people.

"Meet" – G529 apantesis (feminine noun) to meet one, _____

The TPT footnote of this verb says:

The Greek word *apantesis* is not a verb (to go meet) but a feminine noun (to meet or have an encounter), and in this context it is the bride of Christ rising to be with Jesus to have an encounter or "bridal meeting." This rarely used Greek word is also used in the parable of the ten virgins, referring to the virgins rising up to meet (have a meeting) with the bridegroom in Matthew 25:1,6.
